



Negotiation process

- •Transparency in the negotiation process
 - → further efforts needed
- TiSA leak
- •US surveillance programmes



- Excluded from TTIP mandate
- •Trade agreements not forum to negotiate Human Rights standards
- •TiSA leak: Provisions undermining data protection and privacy



The principle that ensures that the internet remains a platform for the enjoyment of human rights such as freedom of expression and privacy

- Legislative debate happening both in the EU and in the US
- •TiSA leak: Provisions undermining EU efforts and contradicts President Obama's statement



- •TiSA leak: Provisions undermining EU efforts to develop protection against mass surveillance
- National security rules: Risk of chilling effect on rights to privacy and data protection

Council of Europe report on Internet and the Rule of Law

Do not stop efforts on transparency	Implement EU Ombudswoman recommendations
Do not include rules on data protection	1.Adopt the GDPR 2.Conclude negotiations on Safe Harbor and the Umbrella Agreement with strong privacy rules & remedy mechanism for EU citizens
Do not include rules on net neutrality	Conclude Telecoms Single Market proposal
Do not undermine digital security	1.Promote use of encryption 2.Implement the EP resolution on NSA surveillance programmes
